Guidelines for using the village Green for parking

Moulton Village Green is the responsibility of Moulton Parish Council and allowing use of the Green for parking is at their discretion. Use of the Green for parking will be considered for community use only and not for commercial events.

This will depend on a number of factors:

- The access gate to the Green is locked to prevent unauthorised access. To allow parking someone needs to be responsible for unlocking the access gate and locking it again after the event. Ideally this would be a parish councillor but in exceptional circumstances Moulton Parish Council may agree to allow someone else to lock and unlock the access gate.
- Weather conditions on the day. If the Green is very wet/waterlogged, parking will not be permitted to prevent damage to the surface.
- Timings of the event. Daytime or village events are easier to manage as more volunteers will be available to unlock the access gate and marshal cars if necessary.

For evening events, the decision to allow the Green to be used will depend on timings as Moulton Parish Council has to be mindful of the noise impact on neighbouring properties. As a general rule parking will not be allowed on the Green for events finishing after 11pm.

The following parish councillors have keys to the access gate: Doug James and Mark Price.
